

Al-Asnag's Family

Highbred Adeni family and known with pioneering and contribution in the economical, social, cultural and political activity in Aden mainly during the British rule and in Yemen generally. From this family two pioneer brothers: Ahmed and Abdulmageed Alasnag, also Mr. Abdullah Abdulmageed Alasnag, the politician and the national known leader.

Al-Asnags' family considers one of the first Adeni families that settled in Sheikh Othman city since structural planning in the end of the nineteenth century (1800) and beginning of the twentieth century (1900), in which the first housing unit was built and established (personal and commercial), up to now still known as Al-Asnag's streets.

Founding Grandfather; Mohammed Said Saleh Al – Asnag. Of northern Yemeni origins, settled in Aden since the middle of the nineteenth century (1800 AD). One of Sheikh Othman city's prominent masters. He was a real estate's owner and Fish merchant. worked in fish trade - as a buyer, seller and supplier- between fishermen's villages of Khaisa, Fouqum and Amran, and the other markets of Sheikh Othman city and Aden colony. Owned a fleet of cars and places to store and sale fish in the most important markets of the city, which made it monopolize its trade at that time. Passed away in the twenties of the twenty century.



Founding Grandfather; Mohammed Said Saleh AI – Asnag



Ahmed Mohammed Saeed Al-Asnag. writer & one of Aden's prominent masters and pioneers of its renaissance, and founder and chair of "Islam Arab Reform Club" in 1930, who struggled to raise the level of morals and spreading and activating knowledge and education, in addition to learning women. He participated to send the first Adeni educational missions to study abroad. Beside, he was the author of the first intellectual book in Aden (Aden's Luck of New Intellectual Movement, 1934), and book of (Scent of Aden, 1960). Passed away in the seventies of the twenty century.

Abdul-Mageed Mohammed Saeed Al-Asnag (father of Abdullah Al-Asnag). Poet and jurist in the sciences of Arabic language and literature, and the author of poetry poems and poems. Many writers and poets of Aden like Garadah, Hanbalah, Miswat, etc. were studied under him. Passed away in the fifties of the twenty century.



Abdullah Abdul-Mageed Al-Asnag (1937 - 2014). A well-known national and political figure inside and outside Yemen. It had a major role in antagonizing colonialism and establishing modern Yemen. Former Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Arab Republic of Yemen (1971, 1974, 1975 - 1978)
