## **Act of Announcing Death\***

With deep grief, the Yemeni Writers Union is announcing the death of well-known Yemeni historian, Mr. Sultan Nagi who died on Friday, 7 April, 1989, in London while he was receiving medical treatment due to a chronic disease that he suffered from for long time.

Mr. Sultan Nagi has many distinguished contributions in the literature life and Yemeni culture for more than a quarter of century. He was born in January 9, 1936, and he loved the civilizations which were created by our Yemeni people, and the history which was written by him, and he participated in formulating pages of his contemporary history.

He was a founder member of the Yemeni Writers Union in its preparatory committee in April, 1970, since the first general conference of the association in February, 1974, he held membership of the executive council for more than twenty years through which he participated in many conferences of Arab Writers' Union and Arab and foreign literary and intellectual forums and sessions; some of which were dedicated for various epochs of Yemeni history. Following his graduation, the deceased occupied many leading offices in the field of education and management, and served as a lecturer in High College of Education - the core of University of Aden, and then he devoted to scientific researches and composition. He was a member of board of directors in many periodicals in the whole homeland and in the Arabian scope, and member of the Common Yemeni Committee for Education, Culture and Information, and member of board of directors of the Yemeni Center for Researches; also he was selected as a member of High People's Council in the south of homeland.

In addition to many published productions, he had abundance of unpublished writings and translations, and until his departure, he devoted himself to translating and collecting documents of the recent and contemporary Yemeni history.


Eternal life to the great deceased.
